Our school management graced us with their valuable words. The inauguration marked it conclusion by 12:30 pm.









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

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
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
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Storytelling is the art to tell stories in order to engage an audience. Sharing stories is virtually as old as language
















World Post Day

With great pleasure, we invited Grade-3 Goenkans to join us virtually on October 23, 2021 and they came out as the heros of science.

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




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
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




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
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Message from the Coordinator
